Horizons Day Program reopen date is **April 12,
2021!!**

**Please note that not everyone will return on
that date but this is the date we will formally
reopen.**

QUESTION 2:

Who will be able to attend on the 12th?

All previous participants that:

- a. Live in Community Concepts, Inc. group homes
- b. Have an active DP Service Authorization in WaMS
- c. Have been fully vaccinated - ALL PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS WILL BE FULLY VACCINATED
- d. Have signed the re-entry documentation

QUESTION 3:

When will external participants be able to attend?

External participants will be admitted on a rolling basis as we continue to build up our workforce.

QUESTION 3:

When will external participants be able to attend?

Once we are in receipt of:

- An active DP Service Authorization in WaMS
- Verification of full COVID Vaccine
- Updated physical/TB, if we do not have it
- Signed re-entry documentation (Vaccine verification form, receipt of revised handbook, COVID protocol agreement)

You will be placed on a “waiting list” and notified directly a few days before your start date.

**Yes, we will review all new referrals and
add them to the “wait list” the order they
are received and accepted.**

Will all 4 sites
be opened?

NO, Initially 3 out of the 4 sites will be open.

All other OMs and PMs are no longer working at Horizons at this time. We will be hiring new management as our census grows.

QUESTION 6:

What will staffing look like upon reopening?

- **All Staff will be fully vaccinated.**
- **All staff will be required to wear N95 masks**

We will honor all required staffing ratios for each service (Community Coaching, Community Engagement and Group Day) as detailed by Medicaid.

Question 7:

How will transportation work?

- All transportation will be through Logisticare unless families will be providing transportation for program participants.
- This includes all participants in the CCI residential program
- Support Coordinators will have to coordinate transportation. (8:30 am drop off; 3:30pm pick up)

Question 8:

What safety protocols will we have in place?

PPE:

- Masks will be REQUIRED by all program participant.
- All staff will be equipped with N95 masks.

Social Distancing:

- Participants will be met at their vehicles and escorted into and out of the programs to reduce traffic and unnecessary interactions.
- Participants will be spaced throughout the sites in small groups
- Sites will be sectioned off to prevent wandering and unnecessary interactions.

Question 8:

What safety protocols will we have in place?

Cleaning:

- **ElectroStatic Sprayers** will be used throughout the entire space at least once in the morning and afternoon. The sprayer can disinfect a space of 10,000 square feet in 5-10 minutes rather than by hand which will take a lot longer.
- Automatic hand sanitizers mounted throughout the sites.
- Daily Cleaning Checklist will be used to ensure that have completed all necessary cleaning/disinfecting. All surfaces (tabletops, doorknobs, remote controls, computer keyboards/mice, light switches, sinks, countertops, books, programming items) will be thoroughly disinfected at the site using disinfectant wipes before the program participants arrive and after they have all left.

Question 9

What will programming look like?

Community Engagement/ Community Coaching

- There will be approved community activities on a daily basis, weather permitting.
 - All community engagement activities will be approved by the Director of Day Support Services.
 - CV will avoid overpopulated locations as well as locations of any confirmed cases of the Coronavirus.
 - While in the community, staff will remind individuals of proper handwashing while in the community. Individuals will utilize hand sanitizer when transitioning from one activity to the next and after completing the activity.
- Group Day Activities:**
- Those that will remain at the site will have numerous planned activities to engage in depending on the theme of the week.

Question 10:

Will things be like they were before the pandemic?

- **No. While we are trying to be as “normal” as possible, things will not be completely the same. We will still have to:**
 - **check temperatures daily**
 - **stay home if we are not feeling well**
 - **keep our hands to ourselves**
 - **not do all the fun activities that we use to do if there are too many people there**
 - **wear our masks all the time**
